Medical Reimbursements

Medical Reimbursement Forms are required to be completed in full to claim eligible reimbursements, then delivered or mailed to the Health Centre. Any receipts without a reimbursement form will not be accepted. Original receipts showing the item or service, the recipient's name, a current mailing address, and the amount are required. Before purchase, it is recommended that you call the Health Centre to find out if the item or service is eligible for reimbursement. Personal insurance and NIHB must be billed before receipts are sent to the Health Centre.

HOUSING DEPARTMENT

Home Insurance

Millbrook First Nation's insurance covers the structural costs of CMHC houses and Millbrook-owned homes on reserve. Please note that the contents inside the homes, including the appliances, are not insured by Millbrook First Nation. It is important to protect your belongings and one way to do that is to consider purchasing home insurance for the contents of your home. This became apparent after the recent flooding of basements that occurred in Millbrook's communities last year. If Millbrook members are interested in home contents insurance, they will be responsible and it will not be covered by the First Nation. Questions? Housing Inspections

The Housing Department has been working collaboratively with other organizations and government agencies with the hopes of obtaining funding for housing repairs. In order to be eligible for the housing repairs, housing inspections will be mandatory for the funding.

Those who contact the Housing Department to be added to the list will be first priority, but it's mandatory for all houses to be inspected. Anyone who doesn't answer the door for their scheduled appointment will be dropped down to the end of the list.

EDUCATION DEPARTMENT

Lunch Allowance and Attendance

In September we had sent notice of a change to our Lunch and Attendance Programs to ensure seamless service to community. As we move into the final months of the school year, we want to remind parents and students of the following:

1. All lunch allowances are paid in full September – May.
2. Attendance reports have been submitted from schools and attendance has been audited for each student.
3. Students who have missed 30 days from September – May will not receive a June cheque as they have been paid in advance but did not attend.
4. Students in grades 7-12 who miss more than three days per month will not receive Attendance Initiative.
5. If students and parents are unsure if their attendance reports have been submitted, they may submit the attendance recorded in Power School to eduadmin@millbrookfn.ca.

Post-Secondary Deadlines for Spring/Summer Application

Please be reminded to contact msani@millbrookfn.ca if you are continuing studies throughout the Spring and Summer semesters at your institution as you will need to apply for funding prior to enrolment. The deadline for submission is May 15th, or earlier depending on when courses start for Spring semester.

Living Allowance for Spring and Summer applicants will commence once all documents are submitted to Millbrook First Nation Department of Education and approved by the Director. Applications will not be approved without the receipt of final transcripts for the previous semester.

The last Living Allowance for students in the 2024 Winter Semester will be issued on or before March 27th, 2024.

Important Reminders

We respectfully ask that parents/guardians PLEASE...

- Call (902-897-1249) or leave a message for your child's teacher if child will be absent or late.
- Call or text the bus driver, **Nolan (902-890-3608)** if your child is not going to school. Texting is best as he starts his bus runs early and cannot answer calls when driving.
- Contact management (not the bus driver or teacher) regarding any requests for changes to bus route, pick up or drop off locations. Any changes must be for the remainder of school year, no daily, weekly, etc. changes will be approved.
- Do not bring children to preschool or primary any earlier than 8:45am (15 mins early).
- Use the front/main entrance to drop off/pick up children. The other front door, off to the side, is for Primary and Afterschool Program use only.
- Do not send anyone under the age of 18 years to pick up your child(ren). Staff will only release child to persons listed on child's original registration form.

*Some other very important excerpts from our Parents Handbook to note:

- No outside food is necessary. All snacks/meals are provided by MEEC. The only exception is if child(ren) have a medical or religious belief that requires a special diet. In these cases, parents/guardians are responsible to provide food items, and must be approved by management.
- Frequent Absences – MEEC's programming is developmental and designed to build off of already learned lessons. If children are frequently absent, they are subject to falling behind. MEEC does not have extra staff to help children catch up on a one-on-one basis, and frequent absences could affect services.
- Sick Policy – To summarize, please keep child(ren) home when sick. Children may return after they are no longer contagious, no fever, no diarrhea, no vomiting, etc., without medication, for 24 hrs.
- Social Media Policy - There is a social media policy for parents/guardians/as well as all MEEC team members. Upon registering a child, parents/guardians should have signed this. If this has not yet been done, management will be reaching out to share this with parents/guardians for completion. In summary, it states that MEEC community members (staff, parents/guardians, volunteers, etc.) are expected to demonstrate personal and professional boundaries and behaviors with each other. Everyone is to ensure that their online behavior reflects the same standards of honesty, respect and consideration that a person uses when communicating person to person, and not cause damage to the reputation of MEEC.

2024 MILLBROOK STUDENT SUMMER EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM

APPLICATION FORMS WILL BE AVAILABLE ON Monday, March 25th, 2024.

The following rules and regulations will be strictly adhered to.

The Millbrook Summer Employment Program's purpose is for students to gain work experience and develop skills in various employment areas.

Due to the large number of eligible students and fiscal accountability, not all students who apply and are interviewed will be hired.

This is the only Summer Employment Program funded by Millbrook Chief and Council. Eligible students will be Millbrook Band Members and/or Status Community Members in Grade 9 or above, 15 years of age and/or under 30 years of age, in good standing with their school, and returning in the Fall. There will be no exceptions to these rules.

Post-secondary students are eligible only if they have had **no more than one year's disruption** in their education and have never held a full-time job. Attendance, work ethics while at school and your performance at last year's summer placement will all be factors that are highly considered during the placement process.

Please make sure the phone number you provide on your application is one you can be reached at. Students will be notified by phone of interview times; if you miss your interview another one will not be granted.

All applicants **MUST** have a Social Insurance Number to apply for summer employment. **NO EXCEPTIONS** can be made.

Summer jobs will be for seven weeks, and all employment will start on Tuesday, July 2nd, and end on Friday, August 16th, 2024.

The Closing Date is Wednesday, May 15th, 2024, by 4:30 p.m. Only applicants who provide an up-to-date resume along with a cover letter and completed application form and qualify for an interview will be contacted. NO EXCEPTIONS.

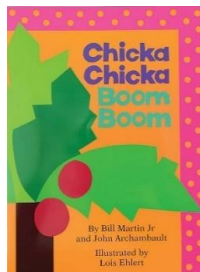

He has experience working within Mi’kmaq organizations and communities through NCNS and CMM which he found rewarding and gained valuable experience working within all of the organizations.

SHEET HARBOUR

We have successfully applied for and received a buyer’s license for the new Sheet Harbour lobster pound, located at the Sheet Harbour wharf. The new lobster pound opened on April 19th, check out the pictures of the beautiful new facility and watch for Grand Opening details, coming soon!

COMMERCIAL FISHERIES

With the smallest hint of spring, the communal commercial fishing season is now upon us. Snow crab fishing is well under way, our vessels have been hard at it since March 15th and the price is a little better than last year. Lobster Fishing Area (LFA) 35 in Digby opened on March 1, but most of our fishers won’t get down there until May. Millbrook has 9 licenses here. LFA 32 in Sheet Harbour opened April 19th and we have 2 licenses here. LFA 26A will also open April 26th, where we have 5 vessels and crews hoping for a good price for the lobsters this year.

Millbrook First Nation’s new website is in development and the staff at Millbrook Fisheries are very excited to be a part of it! When the revamped site is launched, be sure to check out the FISHERIES tab to find links to all the Food, Social & Ceremonial (FSC) Community Harvest Plans as well as the Treaty Jakej/Lobster Livelihood Fishing Plan.

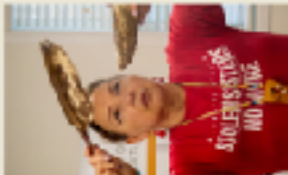
